Children with inhalers

It is vital that if your child requires use of their inhaler in school that the following procedure is followed:-

Inform the class teacher about frequency of use

Agree where the inhaler will be kept in the class room (your child should be able to access it independently)

Hand the inhaler to the class teacher your self

Ensure the inhaler is clearly labelled with your child's name and class

School Library closure

During before and after school hours the school library in the entrance is CLOSED. This is signalled by the screens being placed across the entrance. Please do not allow your children to climb over the bookcases to enter the library during these times,

Home/School diaries
