Hi all,

Welcome back! I hope that you've all had a lovely, relaxing Christmas break. This letter will outline some key reminders, and you can find our 'Curriculum Map' attached also, as well as on our website.

Teaching Arrangements

Miss Watson is the class teacher in Year 3.

Miss McNab will teach us on Monday afternoons whilst Miss Watson plans our lessons. She will teach us music, RE and computing.

This half-term year 3 will spend the first 3 Thursday afternoons learning ART with Mrs Collins. The final 3 weeks, children will spend the afternoon doing PE with Miss Watson.

PE DAYS - Thursday and Friday. Please come to school in your PE kit. Earrings should be able to be removed by children or covered with tape. Hair should be tied back.

Equipment

Please ensure that your child brings to school a water bottle each day, named. As the weather is getting cooler and wetter, we ask for children to bring a waterproof jacket to school everyday in the case of rain. Children should have a pair of wellies to be kept in school. Please ensure they are named.

A change to reading records:

To allow the year 3 team to listen to readers every week, please ensure your child's reading record is available in their bag EVERYDAY. This has changed from a Thursday.

It is expected that you read with your child as much as possible. Reading is an invaluable skill and we appreciate your support in developing your child's reading. Please leave a comment and which pages your child has read at home to allow us in school to change their book when required.

Spellings:

Your child is sent home with new spellings to learn weekly on a Monday. They are to be tested the following Monday. As well as a paper copy, children have access to their spellings on spelling shed.

TTRS:

Children should be accessing TTRS at home for around 10 minutes per night. This helps children develop their fluency of facts and speed, ahead of the multiplication check in Year 4.
