At Seaton Sluice First School:

- We ensure that every child knows they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected in a school where everyone belongs.
- We provide a calm, inclusive environment where all pupils can learn, flourish, achieve and be proud to be themselves.
- Diversity is embraced with pupils. Staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination in accordance with the Equality Act 2010.
- We are good role models to one another, grasping opportunities and striving to be the best we can be.
- We behave in a respectful, considerate and polite way showing kindness towards others.
- We take responsibility for and reflect on our actions and choices.
- We believe that children should be given responsibility, encouraged to develop resilience and support each other, developing a growth mindset.
- We value partnerships and foster trusting, positive relationships between school and home.
- We adopt a THRIVE approach to relational practice, promoting a culture of reflect, repair and restore.
- We actively tackle and prevent bullying, creating a safe, disciplined environment where people feel listened to, speak the truth and feel supported.
- Trusted adults make decisions based on the safest outcomes for the children within our care who we have a duty to prepare for success in real-life. At times, this may involve accepting consequences of actions.
- We recognise behaviour as being communication of unmet needs and develop effective strategies for supporting individuals with exclusion being a last resort.
- We do not tolerate any behaviour that involves prejudice or racist views, or incidents that are threatening or violent.
