<u>PSHE</u>

Mrs Dale will be introducing the children to Saving, Spending and Budgeting and how we can make sensible choices with our money whilst also be influenced by shops and adverts.

<u>Maths</u>

For the first few weeks, children will look at equal parts and fractions of a shape, and in time, a number. We will look at halves, thirds and quarters and the difference between unit and non-unit fractions. Our final challenge will be ordering, adding and subtracting fractions that have the same denominator. Towards the end of the half term, we will look at properties of different shapes, both 2 and 3 dimensional.

Science

This half term we will be looking at Light, including natural and artificial sources. We will explore the difference between opaque, translucent, and transparent materials before moving on to shadows and how these are formed. Finally, we will discuss how we can protect our eyes and bodies from the sun!

MFL

Pupils will build upon their knowledge of numbers and months of the year, children will learn how to ask 'When is your birthday?' and reply 'My birthday is...'. We will look specifically at the pronunciation of our French and begin to see what this looks like in writing.

<u>History</u>

New topic time! We will be looking at Ancient Egypt this term, looking closely at how the first settlers used the river Nile for their civilisation and the successful way of life that the Egyptians led. Children will learn about how they communicated using hieroglyphics, worshiped ancient Gods, and mummified significant

Year 3 – Summer One



Light, Looking at Fractions ad Living like Egyptians

<u>Art/D&T</u>

Mrs Dale will continue to teach Art this half term, looking at pointillism in painting. Children will look at the work of Georges Seurat and create pieces of work in his style, before creating their own inspired piece.

<u>English</u>

For the first few weeks, we will continue to use 'King of The Sky' to support us with speech punctuation, first person narratives and some creative writing tasks. The we will move onto poetry, looking at what it means to be expressive and emotive. We will study key features such as onomatopoeia and alliteration.

<u>R.E</u>

We will look at the Judaism faith and what it means to be Jewish. We will learn about the key beliefs of Judaism and how there are similarities across faiths.

Geography

In Geography we will begin to look at our locality and how this compares to other places around the world, and particularly Tanzania. We will look closely at how Seaton Sluice was developed and the purpose it has as a small coastal town. After studying our own town and country, we will compare this to Tanzania, an LEDC that is growing quickly economically due to its wealth of natural resources. Children will compare the human and physical features of each place and how they have grown according to their landscapes and purpose.

<u>P.E</u>

Whilst Mr Dowson teaches Tag Rugby to Year 3 on a Monday, Miss Brunton will teach Rounders on a Friday. Chance to Dance will also be in school every Friday.

<u>Computing</u>

This half term we will look at sequence in music using software such as Scratch and J2Code. We will discuss what a sequence is and explore with software to both copy sequences and create our own through music.

<u>Music</u>

Mrs Bennett will continue to teach Music for 1 hour each week. Pupils will look at playing learned notes on a recorder and designing their own music.
