Communication in school- reminder of protocol

On Wednesday 13th November, Mrs Bennett met with the Parent and Carer Think Tank. It was a fantastic opportunity to catch up and share views on aspects of school life. One topic that we discussed at length, which also came up from the Parent and Carer most recent questionnaire, was 'communication'. Suggestions included:

- Staff reminding pupils to bring water bottle and reading books home
- Consistent approach when using Class Dojo
- Introduction of a weekly bulletin to remind of upcoming events (on weeks where newsletter is not sent)

Staff discussed these ideas and we are keen to further improve communication to make it more consistent in approach. We would also like your help in remembering:

- If your child is not well or has an appointment, please contact Mrs Johnson at the school office rather than your child's class teacher. This can be done by phone, email or Parent Mail.
- If you have a specific message to share with your child's teacher, this should also be done by email to the school office. Alternatively, a note handed to the teacher at the start of the day is helpful.
- Please remember that when dismissing classes at the end of the day, staff are making sure that the class are returned safely to their parents or carers. Therefore, if you would like to raise a concern or seek advice from your child's teacher, it is best to arrange an appointment either by phone or face-to-face at a convenient time, agreed by the teacher.
- Class Dojo will be used by all teachers to share whole class communications and news. Teachers will not be responding to messages sent via this app.
- PLEASE remember that our school website is updated regularly and contains all essential school information, including a calendar, year group planning details and key policies.
