<u>Finally...'Food for Thought'!</u>

Year 4 have been thinking about the positives and negatives of the internet. In particular, we have been talking about how life has changed over the years and the fact that not as many children 'play out' now. So many of the children mentioned that they would like to play out but are not regularly allowed to.

We then spoke about the importance of decision making and the idea of 'getting trust by earning it'! As preparation for moving onto middle school, are there ways that you can support your child to become more independent, play out with friends (and have less screen time)? Could they be given additional responsibility for helping with tasks such as going to the local shop?

We discussed the importance of small steps such as going there and back to the shop within fifteen minutes. Another idea could be that they walk to a friend's house to play and then their friend could walk them back? Not only will they be developing their independence and navigation skills, but they will be positively impacting their well-being by spending time in the fresh air outdoors, exercising and having fun.

It would be great to follow up this discussion in a few weeks to gather ideas and talk further.
