# Start and finishing times

### **Teaching Arrangements**

Miss Brunton is the class teacher in Year 3.

Mrs Dale will teach the class on a Wednesday afternoon whilst Miss Brunton plans our lessons!

Mrs Walsh will be teaching Year 3 French for the final hour on a Friday afternoon.

#### PΕ

Children will have PE every Monday and Friday.

They should attend school fully dressed in their PE kit, representing their house and wearing appropriate footwear.

## **Equipment**

Please make sure your child brings a water bottle to school with them each day and, if they wish to have one, a snack to eat after breaktime. We advice this is a piece of fruit or a healthy alternative.

When the weather is warmer, we ask children to come to school with a hat and sunscreen.

#### <u>Times Tables</u>

We focus a lot on Times Tables in Year 3 and this is to support pupils when they are formally assessed on their multiplication in Year 4.

Children are expected to practice their multiplication facts at home when possible and this can be done through engaging with Times Tables Rockstars.

Children will practice these regularly in school.

## **Spellings**

Spellings are provided each Tuesday and are chosen in line with our school spelling scheme 'Spelling Frame'. Children will be assigned to a group and over the year, will work through a series of spelling rules.

These will be assigned to your child online and also sent home via paper copy. Please revise these with your child where possible as we will have a 'check' on these the following Tuesday.
