

Maths

It is busy this half term! We will be completing our topic of multiplication and division and learning to do this with some tricky column methods. Miss Brunton will then move the children onto our new topic, money, where we will look into organising and counting money before learning how to give change from an amount.

English

We will be using a fictional picture book, 'King of the Sky' to support our descriptive and narrative writing. We will also begin to look at how speech is punctuated within text and begin to write our own within scripts and eventually, our own narrative.

Geography

We will be continuing our topic of Rainforests and putting our map work to the test! Locating the tropical and temperate rainforests of the world then looking closer at our own locality and how we can compare that to other locations around the world.

PSHE

Children will be recapping and applying their knowledge from last half term's learning, that of E-Safety, Speaking Out and Staying Safe, coding and bullying.

Science

There is no explicit Science topic this half term, so we will be working experiments and our scientific working into other curriculum subjects!
