

English

The children will have daily phonics sessions in which we will consolidate the sounds and tricky words previously taught as well as continuing to follow the Little Wandle phonic scheme. Children will also take part in 3 small group reading sessions per week.

This half term we will be reading "Look up" and "Beegu." We will continue to use a capital letter, finger space and a full stop in our writing. We will also use adjectives and 'and' within our sentences.

We will look at question marks and exclamation marks and begin to use them within our writing.

Maths

This half term we will focus on Number place value (within 20)

This includes:

- Add by counting on within 20
- Subtract ones using number bonds
- Subtraction - counting back
- Subtraction - finding the difference
- Missing number problems

Computing

During ICT sessions the children will explore programming robots. The children will give commands using 'Beebots.' They will learn what each command does and begin to give the beebot multiple commands.

PE

On **Wednesday** we will take part in Makaton Dance sessions with Mrs Melling.

On **Friday** the children will learn Ball Skills.

Science

In Science we will focus on Seasonal change. This will include spending lots of time outdoors exploring!

PSHE-What do we put into and on to bodies.
