

English

The children will have daily phonics sessions in which we will consolidate the sounds and tricky words previously taught as well as continuing to work on Phase 5 sounds and tricky words. The children will also take part in 2 small group reading sessions per week.

This half term we will be reading "The Tiger Who Came to Tea" and "Can't you sleep Little Bear." We will continue to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops within our writing. We will also learn what an adjective is and we will use them within our writing.

Science

Our Science topic this half term is 'Animals including Humans.' We will learn about the different body parts and look at the 5 senses related to them.

Geography

Our Geography topic this half term is the "UK." We will learn about the four countries and capital cities that make up the UK. We will also learn about urban, rural and coastal areas.

Maths

In Maths we will be:

- Counting and understanding numbers within 20.
- Using a number line to 20.
- Comparing and ordering numbers to 20.
- Finding and making number bonds to 20.
- Doubles and near doubles.
- Subtracting ones using number bonds.
- Subtraction-counting back.
- Subtraction finding the difference
- Missing number problems.

Computing

We will learn how to create algorithms and make robots move.

Learners will also describe what information should not be out online without asking a trusted adult first.

PE

On **Wednesday** we will take part in Makaton Dance sessions with Mrs Melling.

On **Friday** we will be taking part in Gymnastics with a sports coach.

PSHE

We will learn about what makes us special and our roles and responsibilities at home and in school.

Art

This half term we will be focusing on painting. We will be exploring Primary and Secondary colours and using a variety of thin and thick paintbrushes. We will explore the Artists 'Paul Klee,' 'Wassily Kandinsky' and 'Piet Mondrian.'

RE

We will be investigating the Jewish Faith.

Music

We will be following our Charanga music program and thinking carefully about rhythm and pitch patterns and we will learn about our composer of the half term, 'Kate Bush.'
